

3rd to 6th class were invited to visit the Sacred Heart Secondary School this month which is on the same campus as SJGNS.


A big thank you to the TY students for providing the students with a lovely introduction to the school.



Library Visit


Pupils from SJGNS were invited to the library as part of Children's Book Festival in October.

It is lovely to be able to welcome Deirdre back to SJGNS. Deirdre teaches French to all classes.










October School Assembly

Pupils of the Month Award – October recipients.




